THE MANY WAYS GOD SPEAKS

Our Lord is so amazing! I am in awe when I think of the many ways He has purposely arranged to speak to us and to open our understanding. The traditions of men often keep us from accepting the ways that God speaks, but as we grow in Christ, we realize that our Lord has not tied us down into a box of rites and rituals, but that He uses things in our daily lives to awaken our connection with His Spirit.

Hearing from God is an absolute necessity for us to grow and mature in Christ. When the man was cast out of the garden (spirit realm), he lost his connection with the voice of God, and so he was totally separated from his source of spiritual life; he was plunged into death.

Jesus promised that His Holy Spirit would "guide us and teach us ALL THINGS and would show us things to come." (Jn.16: 13) And furthermore, "His Spirit would bring all things to our remembrance whatsoever He had spoken to us." (Jn.14:26b) God's Holy Spirit connects us to God's voice; He is the voice of God

Jesus said, "But ye shall receive power after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth." (Acts 1: 8) We cannot be witnesses unto Him if we cannot hear from Him. And we cannot hear from Him if we are not connected to our source of life through the Holy Spirit.

For this reason, the baptism in the Holy Ghost is necessary to open our understanding, not only to the written Word in the Bible, but also to open our spiritual ears and eyes to the many ways that God speaks to us in our daily lives. We receive the Holy Spirit when we first believe, but there is a need to be immersed daily, or baptized in Him who has come to reside within us.

We may have been led to believe that to hear from God we had to perform some kind of religious activity or effort such as chanting or praising until we feel we have entered into the Spirit. Or perhaps we have felt that it is as we kneel in prayer or meditate for hours that the Spirit rises within us. These exercises may be what we feel to do, but they are no help when it comes to hearing from God. God will most likely get through to us during the hours of our nitty-gritty every day life, while we do the dishes or take a shower.

God often speaks in inconspicuous, ordinary ways. At times, He may speak with a strong voice to shake us, but most of the time He is the still small voice in our hearts. Always, He desires for us to seek Him. "Seek and you shall find" says Jesus. And the Psalmist declares, "Blessed are they that keep his testimonies, and that SEEK HIM with the whole heart." (Ps.119:3)

Through the Holy Spirit, our Lord often speaks by means of dreams which are experiences taking place in our spirits or in our souls and transmitted to our conscious minds. Dreams must be caught quickly or they are like a vapor that disappears into thin air. And dreams must be interpreted by the Spirit or they will be meaningless.

The Lord also speaks to us through the things that happen in our lives. He often uses the people in our lives, or animals we know as symbols to explain what He wants to convey. He sometimes uses stories

we have read in books, have seen in a movie or even something we watched on television to communicate with us. I remember the time He confirmed to me that I was to go on a trip. My husband had already passed away and I would have to drive by myself about 300 miles away. I said to myself, this is not from the Lord, I am too old to drive that far by myself. Then that same evening, I turned on the TV and it opened to a channel I seldom watch. It was showing an old broadcast of a Billy Graham crusade. From his pulpit, Billy Graham was pointing his finger and saying to the crowd and seemingly to me, "Moses was eighty years old when God sent him to lead Israel out of Egypt." Wow! That was all I needed to hear of that crusade! I knew God had spoken to me.

God speaks through popular songs too. I remember when in a dream I was singing "La Vie En Rose," an old popular French love song by Edith Piaf. In the dream I was teaching it from the pulpit. The words of the song were clear to my heart. The Lord was going to give me words to turn the hearts of the people to love Him and love Him only.

I have heard song lyrics in my dreams that I had never heard before but then found out that the song was actually a popular love song. Love Me Tender was one of those. God speaks to us in so many ways. I once woke up singing the song, "Gonna Get Along Without You Now." And shortly after that I found myself leaving the Assembly I had been with for many years.

Another time, the song "Auf Wiedershen Sweetheart" started playing in my heart. I had not heard that song since I was a little girl but I knew that it meant "Goodbye" in German. It was the next day that I found myself saying goodbye to a place where I had been visiting.

It is with great love and care that the Lord reaches out to us, to bring us to the place in Christ that He has ordained for us. He is real and He is alive and He is not as our imaginations have made Him to be.

He also speaks to us through the lives of the people of the Old Testament. Their individual personalities and attributes are types and shadows that He uses to teach us. And so it is with things such as the temple and the tabernacle that God commanded Moses to build according to His pattern. God sometimes speaks to us through the nature of animals and their actions and interactions. In dreams, they often depict characteristics or the old nature that is part of us.

As Paul taught us, "...the invisible things of him (God) from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead..." (Rom.1:20) And so I was not surprised when recently, the Lord spoke to me in a dream about "my Prince", and then through a fairy tale that I loved as a child.

MY PRINCE DREAM

In a dream, "I find myself in a far away place, in a very mountainous area. I am there looking for the prince that I am going to marry. I love him so much and have been looking for him in many places. Now I am up in these mountains and I come to a building that reminds me of a castle.

I go in and a man who is dressed like the chef comes out to greet me. I tell him I am looking for my prince. He informs me that the prince is working with the other workers at building this huge castle. I quickly go out to look for him but the place is very difficult to walk through with narrow lanes and deep precipices on each side.

Then I hear voices singing and calling to each other. I know they are the workers building this huge castle and that my prince is among them. I see the foundation of the castle and it is huge and extremely deep. It is an impressive sight to behold. I carefully make my way back out, knowing that my prince has to finish the work and that it is not yet the time for me to join him." End of dream.

As I ponder this dream, the Spirit quickens to me that a prince is the son of a king. This prince represents the Son of the King of kings that is being formed in us. The Son is the Word made flesh and the Word we so desire and love today is a very spe-

cial Word; it is the LAST WORD IF THE LAST TRUMP. It is the Word that will bring about our final transformation. The Lord has spoken many Words in the past and they have become flesh in us, but the final Word that we need and the Word we are now eagerly waiting for and that we so love and desire, is the Last Word of the LAST TRUMP. This is the Prince in my dream.

This is the Word that finishes the building. It is the Word we are going to have union with and marry. It is the Word of God of the last times. It is the Word of the last Trump made flesh in a people. It is the Word we so desire and seek after with all our hearts.

In the dream, the terrain was extremely rugged and even dangerous to walk on. The lanes were very narrow with deep precipices on either sides. The prince and his workers were finishing the foundation of this great castle, and I had to stay out of it. Indeed, no flesh can touch this work. He is building this without hands. We cannot organize meetings of any kind to try to put His body together and get this work finished. I could hear the voice of my prince and I could feel the joy of his heart as he worked fervently and vigorously to finish this castle. This is what is taking place corporately in us now.

"(Christ) from whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body into the edifying of itself in love." (Eph.4: 16)

Indeed, God's chosen people of the last times are those who are hearing the final Word AND BELIEV-ING IT. Just as those who went before us heard the Word of Passover and believed, and in time others heard the Word of Pentecost and believed, so the people of the last times are hearing the Word of the Last Trump and believing until it is fully come to pass.

It is as we hear and believe the Word of the Last Trump that we become the new creation in Him. Our faith in the Word we hear must endure through persecution, discouragement or testing by fire to the end. In the dream, the huge castle with deep foundation is the habitation of God in the Body of Christ. The work cannot be stopped, for that which He has begun will be completed in all His called out ones. No one is ahead of the other in the Body of Christ. He is now working to erect the entire body in the earth.

Were the workers with Him angels, or ministering spirits to the heirs of salvation? Were they those who have crossed over to the other side of the veil? I don't know. But I do know that they without us cannot be made perfect and I have seen them in dreams waiting eagerly to enter in to their better resurrection. This work is being done in the secret hidden place of our spirits, and it will not be revealed until it is complete or perfect.

The fruit of our union between the Son or the Word of God and our soul and body will not appear until the entire body is ready to be revealed. This is the work that is vigorously going on in the Spirit at this time. Just as it was in my dream, the son (prince) and the workers are very busy, happily rejoicing as they are completing the building.

SNOW-WHITE

I was just eight years old when my mother took me to the renown Graumont theater on the Champs-Elysees in Paris. It was the premiere showing of Walt Disney's Snow-White perfectly dubbed in French; and all the songs were sung in French too.

I had just been through another surgery on my ears and the bandages were still wrapped around my head. My mother had tied a big bow on top of my head and she laughed as she called me her Easter egg. But none of these things mattered to me as I was absolutely enamored and fascinated by the story of Snow-White and her Prince. At my young age I loved to read and I had already read many books and great stories, but none had touched me for days as had this one.

As I grew up, I forgot about Snow-White, although I always had a fond memory of that night. One day, a dear sister in the Lord who had gone to Disney World in Orlando, brought me a little broach of

Snow-White as a souvenir. She had no idea of my former fascination with the story. This was several years ago but now the Lord has put it all together for me. It was the Lord who had stirred my young soul when I saw the love of the prince for Snow-White and His tender touch and kiss to awaken her love for him. This had been a preview of the time when God's Holy Spirit would come to awaken within me the desire and love for His Last Word. The delight and jubilation that I had felt even as a child, were the precursors of the feelings that would one day reach out to the Prince of Peace and Lord of my life.

Snow-White's song rung in my heart for days. The French words translate like this: "One day my prince will come...One day he will tell me, words of love so thrilling and tender, that I will have so much pleasure to hear...Let him come for I am waiting with my heart beating so strongly within...In his arms, my beautiful enchanted dream, will become reality."

There are several versions of these lyrics, but those were the ones I learned in French. And truly, now I realize that it was Him all along, preparing me for the day of His revealing within. We can all relate to this, for this stirring fairy tale is also the love story of the true bride of the Lamb.

Within each one of His called out people, is hidden the need to be awakened by true love. We live in an unsafe world. So many dangers lurk around every corner, yet through it all we find that He has been wooing us and holding us close to His heart. Little by little, His love has been turning us from darkness to His marvelous light.

God spoke to me by choosing Snow-White and her Prince as a type of the love story that is unfolding in us. It is similar to the story of the Shulamite as she was taken in captivity, in the luxury of the king's palace while her heart yearned for her true Lover away in the vineyards of Engedi. It is as the story of Ruth laying herself down at the feet of Boaz. It is our love story revealed in the many ingenious, delightful and profound ways that God chooses to speak to us.

What we feel stirring within our hearts is the desire

for this union with the Prince that is awakening the passion for truth and pure love that He placed within us from the beginning of time. It is no coincidence that the main character was called "Snow White" for truly He is preparing His bride and making her white as snow. "Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord; though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool." (Isa.1:18)

Snow-White had been through much persecution. The queen was extremely jealous of her beauty and when her attempt to kill her had failed, she found a treacherous way to hide the deadly poison in a delicious looking apple. When Snow-White fell into a death like sleep, her seven friends who loved and protected her, laid her in a glass coffin in the middle of the forest. It was there that her Prince found her and with a loving kiss brought her back to life.

The seven dwarfs helped her and kept her safe, but they could not bring her back to life. Only Christ has the power to impart to us the love of God that raises us into eternal life.

THE RIGHTEOUSNESS OF FAITH

"But the righteousness which is of faith speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down from above;) Or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.) But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach. (Rom. 10: 6:8)

It is by faith that we receive the word of God in our heart and speak it from our mouth. By faith, we receive the Word that connects our spirits with our thoughts and when we open our mouth to speak, it is the Spirit and not us that we hear. For most of us, it is not easy to believe such a thing could possibly be so.

The problem is that the teachings of most religions, implant in us the fear to be deceived more than the need to trust the God's Holy Spirit within. "Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy." (Jude 24)

Jude addresses his letter to those who are set apart for God's purpose with these words, "to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ and called.." Indeed we are PRE-SERVED IN JESUS CHRIST. He keeps us from being deceived by revealing our hearts to us and taking us through purification by fire.

Jesus said that in the last days, "There shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew forth great signs and wonders; insomuch that, IF IT WERE POSSIBLE, they shall deceive the very elect." (Matt.24:24)

If it were possible the elect would be deceived. But it is not possible. Not because they are so special and smart. Not because they have studied up on it under the best teachers. None of these things. But because they have been made virgins and given a new heart. They have been passed through the fire and came out without the smell of smoke! This is the mighty, wonderful work of God's Holy Spirit. Bless the Lord!

And there is one more way that He keeps us from being deceived and that is to TRY OR PROVE THE SPIRITS. "Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God.

And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God. It is that spirit of antichrist whereof ye have heard that it should come and is even now already in the world."(I Jn.4:1-3)

Jesus Christ came in the flesh when He was born of Mary. But after His ascension, Jesus returned as His indwelling Spirit in the believers. We do not have an "outward" God as the heathen do. We will never have an "outward" God. It is the spirit of antichrist that has brought that teaching which began even at the time of John's writing.

Therefore, the test is to find out if these spirits believe that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. We know that He has not only come in the flesh of the baby that Mary birthed, but He has come in the flesh of His called out ones through His indwelling Holy Spirit.

I have also found by experience that it is good to test the spirits or the motivations that are behind the word I hear. The motives of the hearts in the one who speaks the word or the motives of my own hearts when I hear it, must be checked out. For instance when I have a dream and look for interpretation, it is easy to make myself look pious and holy in the dream. It is also easy to find that I symbolize the pure bride without spot or blemish.

Note that John did not say to test the word; he said to test the spirits. The motives of the heart are what need to be tested always. We accept or reject words because they are either contrary to what someone may think of us, or they reveal a part of us that we are not ready to deal with. We may accept the word of certain preachers over the truth because we are afraid to rock the boat or to offend someone we love. There are all sorts of things that must be tested as we receive the word.

But when we know that our motives are pure we need not be afraid to be deceived, for nothing can hinder us from receiving the Word of truth. With a pure heart, one will not be deceived. If we cannot believe that our Lord is able to keep us from falling, we cannot receive the new truths that His Holy Spirit is speaking at this time.

When we still need our mentors to confirm truths, we have not learned to trust the witness of His Spirit and we are yet babes in need of milk. The example of young Samuel who was raised in the house of Eli is so graphic for us. Samuel heard God calling him in the night but three times he thought he was hearing from Eli. Finally after the third time, Eli perceived that Samuel was hearing from God and he told him, "...if he call thee, thou shalt say, Speak, Lord; for thy servant heareth." (I Sam.3:9b)

We also have been raised in an old religious order, and so when the Spirit speaks to us directly, our first response is to run to our leaders. The old story of the eagle raised in the chicken coop is very graphic. For a time, the eagle struggled and grew among the

chickens scratching in the manure to find his daily grub, but the time came when he heard the call of other eagles flying high in the sky. At first he was fearful to spread his wings and soar, but when he finally did, all fear was gone for he knew that he was not a chicken after all.

"Faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the Word of God." (Rom.10:17) The more we exercise ourselves in hearing from God and the more that the Word we hear comes to pass in our lives, the greater our faith becomes. In the old Adam nature, we had lost our ability to hear from God. Salvation is the process that brings us to the place where we can hear His voice again.

In Adam, our life has been arranged by the knowledge we derived from the carnal mind. Francis Bacon, a philosopher, coined the phrase "knowledge is power." Knowledge is the power of the Adam man. Man climbs the ladder of prestige and fame among his peers through knowledge. But in reality, man with all his knowledge and fame still ends up in the grave. It is our connection with God's Spirit that is true power. In Christ we are reconnected with the true source of life.

Jesus told His disciples, "But ye shall receive POWER, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses onto me both in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth." (Acts 1:8)

True power is to know God. It is to see and to know what He is doing in the earth. The first disciples were endowed with this power and because of it, Christ was preached unto the uttermost part of the earth. This has not stopped.. even though, from its beginning, the opposition has been fierce at work to put a stop to it.

Man's connection to God is the power that has been under heavy fire from the forces of man's knowledge. Most scientists and "brilliant minds" are not ready to acknowledge God in their lives. Carl Sagan was an astronomer, he was also an activist and coined many phrases about religion and God. He once declared, "We live in a society exquisitely de-

pendent upon science and technology.." Among his many sayings, he said, "People believe in God because of their need to believe that someone is looking out for humanity."

If this were true, humanity would have been extinct long long ago. Carl Sagan among others was a bright mind and he persevered in a field of knowledge that still amazes people. However he and others who follow in the field of knowledge without acknowledging Christ, are as Cain whose works produced only the fruit of his own garden.

Paul tells us that in Christ "are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge." (Col.2:3) Daniel explains, "..Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his: and he changeth the times and the seasons; he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding." (Dan.2: 20-21) The Word of God in our hearts is the true source of wisdom and knowledge. The more we hear and receive the Word of God in our hearts, the stronger our faith grows.

Paul said, ".. If thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." (Rom. 10:9) We know that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, but one can read the Bible every day and still not be saved. It is faith in the living Christ that saves, not knowledge of the written Word.

By faith we believe that the Bible is the Word of God. By faith we agree with our teachers and our peers that God raised Jesus from the dead, but our faith is not on solid rock until we hear. Him speak through His Holy Spirit and believe. We are called to be His witnesses. True witnesses sees with their own eyes and hear with their own ears. It cannot be what someone else saw and heard; that is hearsay and it is not acceptable in any court of law, nor is it acceptable from our Lord's witnesses.

Our spiritual ears and eyes are opened as the Lord reveals Himself to us. This is not accomplished in one day; it is a continuous work of His Holy Spirit who speaks to us and opens our understanding. It is done through much repetition. In my heart, I heard Him tell me that I no longer belonged in the Community Church, but it was through the events that took place in my life that I truly believed it. I felt the witness in my spirit and I knew that I had heard Him. I confessed it to the pastor who urged me to leave the church.

The Lord will often send us a strong witness of what we hear through someone sharing their experience or what they have learned from the Spirit. When I first heard that there were no streets of gold in the Holy City, but that the city was indeed the gathering of His people having come to a walk in God's pure nature (gold), it witnessed so much to me that I knew I had heard it in my heart. I needed no confirmation.

Reading the Bible is not what saves us. Traditions are made after the Law and the righteousness of the Law; so it is where we feel safer. But it is by the righteousness of faith that we are saved. Paul insists, "For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believeth." (Rom.10: 4)

NOT MY WILL BUT THINE BE DONE

Most Christians are well acquainted with these words that Jesus uttered as the day of His crucifixion came closer, "Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me nevertheless not my will, but thine be done." (Lk.22:42)

In His hour of deep travail, Jesus was turning His will over to the Father. Jesus had a will of His own; and so it is for all the sons of Adam. So how do we reconcile that truth with the knowledge that our God is sovereign? Indeed God has the last word on everything. In the end, God has the last "stamp of approval."

What we need to realize is that when God created the heavens and the earth, He set the galaxy of which our solar system and milky way are a part of, in the structure of "time." Everything and everyone that God set in this "heaven and earth" creation is subject to TIME, and time has limits or boundaries. God created the sun, the moon and the stars to control the days and the nights upon the earth. Everything that

God has created for man is regulated by Him and has time limits.

When Adam and Eve were still in Eden they were innocent from sin and could have lived forever. But when through disobedience, they entered the realm of death, they became subject to the limitations of time. Eternity is forever, but thank God, death has time limits. This is God's love for His creation. Our loving Father will not let us stay in this continuous cycle of death forever. And so the wise man wrote, "To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven." (Eccl.3:1)

The Adam man that God created and set with his wife to reproduce his image in the earth, has been given dominion in the world, and also a "will" to make the decisions needed. This also is subject to time. Yes, each man goes to the grave after so many years and the Adam creation-man also has an end of existence in the earth. This is why Jesus is called THE LAST ADAM.

This is why Jesus cried out on the Cross, IT IS FINISHED. "When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, it is finished, and he bowed his head and gave up the ghost. (Jn.19: 30) Jesus is the end of the Adam creation man, and the beginning of the new.

"And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the LAST ADAM was made a quickening spirit. Howbeit that was not first that which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual. The first man is of the earth, earthy; the second man is the lord from heaven."

"As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy; And as is the heavenly such are they also that are heavenly. And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly." (I Cor.15:45-49)

Jesus is not only the new man, He is also the Savior of the world. Not only did He put an end to the old Adam, He also began the new creation man. Jesus is the beginning and the end. He is the Alpha and Omega. The old Adam is not banished forever from

the earth or destroyed, he is being transformed into a new creation. Oh! What wonder! What love! What a magnificent plan! This is one of the mysteries that we are now understanding by the Spirit. We read it and believed it, but now we are experiencing its effect in our lives. Our image is changing. This means that we are no longer the same species that we were in the first Adam man.

All that is in the world today, has been established by the first Adam man. The order of societies, and the governments of nations in relation to each others, constitute the patterns in which the earth is moving today. Such orders were instituted by the will of the f Adam man because God had delegated the keeping of the earth unto him.

During that time, man not only demonstrated his great intelligence; that is the good side of the tree of knowledge. But man also demonstrated his ugly side, which is the antichrist, rebellious, greedy, murderous side. John explains, "Little children, it is the LAST TIME; and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time." (I Jn.2:18) The LAST TIME began shortly after the resurrection of Jesus. We have been in the LAST TIME ever since, and the spirit of ANTICHRIST is hard at work among us.

The Antichrist is not a one man figure, the antichrist is a serpent spirit that dwells in the tree of knowledge of good and evil. That tree is the carnal mind that has been ruling every son of the first Adam man. Some of these carnal minds have been brilliant in their own way.

Some have become rulers and leaders. Most have developed strong, independent minds that helped them climb the ladder of success among men. But all have been "antichrists" or impostors who have usurped the place that rightfully belongs to Christ.

Today, the strongest antichrist spirits are taking over the nations, pushing in every possible way to force the image of God and His Christ out of creation. These are the powerful antichrist spirits of the last times that are bringing devastation over the planet. But have no fear and believe. Jesus said then and is saying now by the Spirit, "For in those days shall be affliction, such as was not from the beginning of the creation which God created unto this time, neither shall be. And except that the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved; but for the elect's sake, whom he hath chosen, he hath shortened the days." (Mk.13: 19-20)

When we look at what is happening through the eyes of the Spirit, we can truly rejoice. This is the culmination of the last words of Jesus on the cross, "IT IS FINISHED!"

What Jesus meant is that it would take three days (a day as a thousand years) for Him to rebuild the temple of His body. And so since His ascension, He has been rebuilding by His Spirit. Jesus died as the LAST ADAM, but He rose again as the first of a new creation, THE SECOND MAN, THE LORD FROM HEAVEN. And when He did, He took all of creation with Him. It would have to enfold each in his own time, and in his own way. Through His death, Jesus obtained a new seed that He is planting in the earth of this earthly man. The new man that is being born again in you is the new man from heaven.
