# Rehemiah to Messiah

The beginning of Daniel Chapter 9 shows the context of Daniel's prayer to be in regard to years. The angel's reply is showing Daniel that not just 70 *years* need to pass, (as had just passed for the Babylonian Captivity), but also seventy 'sevens', or 490 *years* had yet to be fulfilled before Jerusalem would be a *permanent* place of peace.



**Command to Rebuild the City**  
by the later Artaxerxes the Persian

Summary Chart

In summary; from the issuing of the command to rebuild the city of Jerusalem until the Messiah, (Promised Seed of woman), comes will be 49, (seven 'sevens';  $7 \times 7 = 49$ ), plus 434, (sixtytwo 'sevens';  $62 \times 7 = 434$ ), which is 483 years, ( $49 + 434 = 483$ ). After the 483 years though, the Messiah will be "cut off", (killed). This is 7 years short of the full 490 years that the angel Gabriel mentions is necessary to fulfill all prophecy.
