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WHEN GOD AVENGES THE BLOOD OF HIS SAINTS

WHERE DO SOULS GO?

"And when he (the Lamb) had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar, the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held. And they cried with a loud voice, saying How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? And white robes were given unto them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellow-servants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled." (Rev.6:9-11)

These verses bring up many questions. What happens to our souls after we leave these earthen bodies? What are these white robes that are given to these departed souls? Why are they waiting under the altar and crying with a loud voice for God to avenge their blood?

The robes are essential. White speaks of the right-eousness of Christ. The robes speak of coverings or bodies. Our soul is the expression, identity and consciousness of the body. Body and soul are one unit. When our body goes to the grave and decays, the soul loses its covering and its life. This is why we have need of a Savior and Christ is the Saviour of our bodies or our covering. Paul explains that "...the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church; and he is THE SAVIOUR OF THE BODY." (Eph. 5:23)

In Strong's dictionary, the Greek word translated "body" has a wide implication. It is derived from a word that means to preserve, to save or make whole. By revelation of the Spirit, we conclude that when Christ saves our body, He saves all that giveslife to the body. Paul prayed, "And the very God of peace

sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit, soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ." (I Thes.5: 23)

The Spirit is the life of our body and soul. When a person dies, the spirit goes back to God. "Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was; and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it." (Eccl.12:7) On the cross Jesus cried with a loud voice, "...Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit; and having said thus, he gave up the ghost." (Lk.23:46)

Because our God loves His creation. He has made a way for our earthen souls and bodies to be saved from corruption. After the initial baptism in the Holy Spirit, Peter stood up with the eleven and addressed the people who had gathered from nations everywhere to witness this amazing event.

He explained how God had raised up Jesus Christ from the dead. He speaks of the many things that were about to take place as a result, and he added, "And it shall come to pass that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord SHALL BE SAVED." (Acts 2: 21) This was the only requisite for the soul to be saved.

Peter then quotes the words of David who had seen the Lord and rejoiced, "Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh (body) shall rest in hope. Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell (Hades), neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption." (Acts 2:26-27)

The word which has been translated "hell" in this verse is actually Sheol or Hades which is "The world of the dead." This is not a place of fiery punishment,

it is a place where God sends the souls who die without the knowledge of Christ, to be preserved from decay. There is also a place for the believers who die in Christ. A thief on the cross next to Jesus became a believer when he asked Jesus to be remembered in His kingdom. Jesus said, "Today shalt thou be with me in paradise." (Lk.23:43) This thief's soul did not go to the "world of the dead," (Hades), he went directly to the place for Christian believers.

Brand new Christians who become believers just before they die, are saved from going to Hades. Their souls escapes death and they go to a place for the living called, "paradise." There, they await the resurrection of their bodies. The Lord Jesus is the covering of their soul. They are saved and not found naked.

Paul speaks about being clothed with our house from heaven (spiritual covering) "If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked." (II Cor.5: 3) This is speaking about our soul. "For we that are in this tabernacle (earthly body) do groan being burdened; not that we would be unclothed, but clothed upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life." (II Cor.5: 4)

A soul that loses its body is naked. If it were not for Jesus our Savior, the soul would have no place to live, no covering and no life. Our Savior provides places or coverings for our souls. The believer goes to "Paradise" where his soul finds covering and life. The unbeliever goes to the world of the dead or Hades where he is groomed and preserved to await the day of judgment and resurrection. There is also a place called Tartarus or Gehenna which is also translated "hell." No one goes there at the time of death.

In my dreams I visited some of these places. I have seen what happened to a soul in Hades. One of my husband's brothers, Duke, had been very close to Michael when they grew up. He was extremely offended when we married, and more so when we became Christians. He turned on us and would not talk to us for at least ten years. As he aged, he came back to us but only to argue and try to rile us up about our faith. However, he kept coming and seemed to have a need to keep talking about our "religion". When he

died unexpectedly, I dreamed, "Duke was in the morgue, laying face down on a gurney. There were doctors in white coats surrounding the gurney. They turned him around on his back and I could see that he began to breathe. Then they began to groom him. They trimmed his hair and his mustache and were washing his face." End of dream

When I woke up I knew that when Duke died, he was taken to the place of the dead (morgue) or Hades. In that place, he was attended by healing angels assigned to the task (doctors in white coats). They brought him back to life (he began to breathe), and were getting him ready for judgment and resurrection.

This is a good example of what happens to the unbelievers after they leave their mortal bodies. They are not sent into a fiery hell; they are sent to a place where they are prepared for their judgment and resurrection day.

Whether one leaves this earth as a believer or an unbeliever, the Savior provides a place so that the soul is not destroyed. Jesus is the Savior of all bodies, then comes the judgment and resurrection. Hades is not a place of eternal burning. If it were so, Christians who lose their unbelieving loved ones would bewail and howl in despair at their funerals.

Some have been called and chosen (Jn.15:16). "They have been tried and found worthy to have part in the First Resurrection. They have their Father's name in their foreheads. They have followed the Lamb to the cross daily. Some are gathered under the Altar of Incense waiting to enter the Holy of Holies (place of perfection in Christ). They are clothed in bodies of righteousness (white robes).

"Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection; on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years." (Rev. 20: 6) These are very much alive and crying with loud voices from under the Altar, unable to enter the Holy of Holies and find their completeness because "They without us should not be made perfect." (Heb.11:40b).

GOD'S AVENGING

Over the centuries, Christians and Jews have suffered great persecutions just because of their faith in Jehovah and Jesus. Today, the move to annihilate Christians and Jews from the face of the earth is stronger than ever. Jews have already suffered immensely and have lost multitudes of their own to horrible deaths They are still continually targeted in their own land and places of worship. We have entered the battle of the ages, and the closer we come to the time of Christ's ruling, the worse it will get.

Whether from this side of the veil or the other, Christians are calling on God to deliver them from the powerful forces that threaten their lives and posterity. Although this hatred and animosity come at the hands of men, the power behind the scene comes from the spirit of ANTICHRIST which was already in the world at the time of Cain and Abel. It showed up with strong animosity against the Lord Jesus when He walked this earth, and it has been rising in full force against His true followers. The apostle John warned that it was already among them.

Antichrist is the most vicious, powerful and murderous spirit. It comes with many faces which slyly and insidiously entice us unawares. It persuades them to perform his wicked work among men. The Antichrist spirit is the force that pushed the Pharisees to order the crucifixion of Jesus. It's goal is to harass, torture and destroy Christians and Jews from the face of the earth so that no one is left to mention the name of Jesus and Jehovah.

The saints under the altar are tired of waiting for the Lord to move on their behalf. They want to see that spirit bound forever. This is the avenging that they are calling for. But they have to remain patient until all that God has spoken by all His prophets is fulfilled. God will not let this corrupt and despicable spirit thrive and multiply any longer than needed. The Almighty will avenge.

Paul instructs, "Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay saith the Lord." (Rom.12: 19) And Isaiah clearly proclaims "...the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn..." (Isa.61:2) Isaiah describes the zeal of the Lord, "For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation upon his head; AND HE PUT ON THE GARMENTS OF VENGEANCE FOR CLOTHING, and was clad with zeal as a cloak." (Isa.59: 17)

There is no doubt, the Lord is eager to put an end to the cruelty and carnage that has been directed at His people. The Spirit that the Lord Jesus imparted to us is the Spirit of the OVERCOMER. Individually, we are called to overcome all that is of the world, the flesh and the devil within us. But as a body, together we are called to overcome the flesh, the world and the devil in creation. The overcoming that we do individually is practice for the overcoming that we are called to do as a body.

In the world, we are called to be as He is. We become Christ in His body and as Christ we are cloaked with His zeal to overcome and destroy the enemies of our Lord and of His Christ. Putting every enemy under our feet, (the feet of Christ), is the ultimate calling of this powerful move of God. "For he (Christ) must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. The last enemy that shall be DESTROYED is death." (I Cor.15: 25-26) Our spirits have been quickened and our souls are working out their salvation or deliverance from death. Then by the power of holiness, our bodies will overcome death as well.

The work within is done as the Spirit passes each one, alone, through the fiery trials and testing. Yet, it is together as members of His body that we find the strength and comfort to move on. Indeed, we are alone working out our salvation (deliverance from death). Our walk is a death to the self and death is experienced ALONE. Nevertheless we stand together with the same vision, the same goal and basically the same trials even as all who have gone before us. Jesus was tested in ALL WAYS, EVEN AS WE ARE.

Recently a brother was inspired to write a little song which he entitled, "TOGETHER, ALONE." If we should feel down for being alone, we might just think of the many on this same journey. And so the little

song reminds us, "Abraham was called...Alone, Climbed the mountain top...Alone, Offered up his son...Alone, Together Alone. Isaac roamed the land...Alone, he re-dug the wells...Alone, kept the promised seed...Alone, Together Alone. Joseph in the pit...Alone, Hannah in the church.. Alone. Mary great with child...Alone.

Spotless Lamb of God...Alone, nailed upon the tree...Alone, in an empty tomb...Alone, but He wasn't alone. Raised up from the dead...Alone, with power and majesty...Alone, had the victory...Alone but He isn't Alone. God will not forsake...His own, though it seems we're all Alone...but we're never Alone. Together Alone, we're together Alone.

Indeed we have been as the stones of the temple, hewn and polished alone in the quarry, but we are coming to the place when, shiny and ready we will solidly fit together as one and stand side by side, built up as a spiritual house unto our God on this earth.

We may someday find that there is life on other planets, but as far as God has revealed to me, it is planet earth that He has chosen to reveal His Son in the beauty of holiness and righteousness forever. It is on the earth that life will have overcome the sting of death forever. It was when He had created the heaven and the earth that God said, "Let us make man in our image and after our likeness." (Gen.1:26).

Ever since He formed man from the dust of the ground, the Lord God has been molding man into that image and likeness. The garden of the earth holds all the ingredients necessary to bring up the man of dust to that end. What a magnificent work of genius and love!

Just as a woman with child, the earth that we are has been forming this new man within. And now she is getting ready of offer the fruits of this new creation unto God. Jesus was the first of these firstfruits. We have come to the time of birthing and the pangs are coming stronger and closer together. At the same time, the entire creation is also feeling the pains of this birthing. They cannot understand what is happening and they are resisting. They are angry and

frustrated trying to fix things their way, but nothing works the way it used to work and the pain is not going away.

THE NIGHT IS SOON OVER

"I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work." (Jn.9:4) Jesus was announcing that a period of great darkness was coming upon the people of the earth. As long as He was physically in the world, truth was available; there was light. But soon He would leave, the last prophet of God had been slain and no one had ears to hear or eyes to see. The world would have no direction for the future. It would be plunged into the greatest darkness ever.

Our God was not unmindful of the coming gross darkness upon the world, it was part of His plan. All that He has spoken through His holy prophets has to be fulfilled. There needed be more time for that to come to pass. This is what He told the saints under the altar. This is why Peter, when filled with the Holy Spirit, told the Jews gathered at Jerusalem that Jesus Christ had to be retained in heaven "...until the time of the restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began." (Acts 3: 21)

Through the prophets of the Old Testament, God laid out His complete plan for His creation. This is why every word that was spoken has to be fulfilled or come to pass in the earth. This includes God's complete judgment for all people. Since His ascension, Jesus has been building His church. She is the true bride that gives birth to the sons after His image. The prophets have announced the coming of the Son of God and of His government in the world. "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given...Of the increase of His government and peace there shall be no end..." (Isa.9: 6a, 7a)

By His Holy Spirit, Jesus has been building His true church while the world has been kept busy worshiping at the feet of the Harlot. This too has been God's doing to protect the true Seed. It has been His camouflage while an "underground" work of the Spirit has taken place. The world, in gross darkness has no idea about the coming manifestation of God's sons.

Even Christians are waiting to see Jesus appear in the sky and scoop them up away from the tribulations of the earth. The only light of truth that the world has had access to since Jesus physically left the earth, is through the ministry of those who are indwelt by His Holy Spirit. Consecrated and devoted evangelists and missionaries have been working hard in the fields to call sinners to repentance. Many good pastors have cared for the sheep with the light that they have, but mostly, ministers have become professionals, trained to convert people to their creed, and to teach them to serve their churches. Yet, by God's grace, even when they feed the flock with the letter of the word, they still hold up the name of Jesus and His work on the cross.

The church that Jesus has been building by the Spirit is the Light that is soon to appear in the world. But as the Light is arising and getting brighter in His people, the world is going through a time of distress and destruction. The old must make room for the new. When John saw the new heaven and new earth, he heard a great voice saying, "Behold, I make all things new..." (Rev.21:5a)

The passing away of the old world causes fear and great anguish to those who are caught unaware. "But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in which the heavens shall pass away with great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burnt up." (II Pet. 3: 10)

This is what we see happening in the world today. The heavens are the powers that have been ruling the world. And so we witness governments of nations crumbling everywhere. The elements are the components or the things that made these governments work; they are melting under the fervent heat of the word of truth that is rising to replace them. And thus all the works of men are being burnt up. Just as the Ancient world that we have learned about, this world will not be revived. It will soon be only ruins and ashes. It will soon replaced by God's Kingdom.

By the Spirit, the prophet Joel warns, "Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble:

for the day of the Lord cometh, for it is nigh at hand. A day of darkness and of gloominess; a day of clouds and thick darkness, as the morning spread upon the mountains, a great people and a strong; there hath not been ever the like, neither shall be any more after it, even to the years of many generations." (Joel 2:1-2) A GREAT PEOPLE AND A STRONG. This is Christ in His body arising in the world. It is the day of the fall of mystery Babylon and the day of the long-awaited VENGEANCE OF OUR GOD.

THE DAY OF GOD'S VENGEANCE

"And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their place. And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; and said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us and hide us from the face of him that sitteth upon the throne, and from the WRATH OF THE LAMB." (Rev.6: 14-16)

Among the several translations given for the word "wrath", we find PASSION, ANGER and VENGEANCE. The wrath of the Lamb is a time when He no longer comes as the meek One who lays His life down, but now appears as the passionate, angry One who has come to avenge His saints.

Luke tells the story of the widow who went to the judge to be avenged of her enemies. At first the judge ignored her cry, but when she would not let him go and kept after him, he could no longer deny her. "And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith, And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them? I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?" (Lk.18: 6-8)

Why would vengeance be taken out of our hands and executed by God Himself? For the simple reason that we would be prone to revenge rather than avenge. There is a great difference between the two. TO AVENGE IS TO PUNISH A WRONGDOING WITH THE INTENT TO BRING JUSTICE. RE-

VENGE IS LESS OF JUSTICE AND MORE FOR RETALIATION. This is why vengeance belongs to God only. His vengeance will be just, swift and complete. It will destroy the Antichrist spirit and all his works from the world, but it will judge the people in righteousness. "And he shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness." (Ps. 9:8)

The Lamb alone has the power and the right to open the seals and to avenge His elects. It is the Lamb and His followers who have been abused and slain. Now it is the Lamb who rises up to avenge them. But first, all the elects must have laid their lives down and be slain

Some have been slain physically but for most it is their Word that has been silenced. They have been forbidden to preach or to teach in the pulpits of the visible church. I remember once when I prophesied in a Charismatic church that we attended for a time. The pastor sent an elder to visit us at home. He informed us that we were very welcome to worship with them, but we were to keep silent in the church and also to keep our beliefs to ourselves. We did not stay there; the Word we held had been slain again. Later the dear elder who had been sent to us apologized and left that church as well.

The more truth that is revealed to us, the more we get separated from those who were once our friends. This process begins when we first become believers and continues every step of the way. Where we were once loved, we are now hated. Make no mistake, the reason our present President is so hated is not because of his personality; it is because he is restoring Christian liberties and supporting the nation Israel. These are things that makes the devil tremble and that the world abhors.

The spirit of this world is portrayed in the Revelation, by the great RED DRAGON. The color red denotes "anger." The red dragon is filled with anger. It is an enraged, dangerous reptilian spirit, poised to devour God's new creation in Christ This dragon spirit is targeting the next generations of young minds, feeding them with lies to entice them to worship him, the same way the serpent enticed Eve. That spirit is

out to control. Red is also the banner of "communism." This RED dragon is out to bring the world into one mind and one accord so that he can ultimately destroy the entire creation. When we look at the world's nations, we see the trend that they are following. They have been brainwashed into thinking that a "state controlled system" is the answer to the world's problem. They do not see the pit falls of what they are asking for.

Our country still holds on to Christian principles, but they are weakened because the true Gospel has been warped and distorted. True Christianity is fading away with each century that goes by. If it were not that God's plan and purpose is on track, we would have no chance of winning this warfare.

But the truth is that these are the last days of the Adam man dominion. God has raised up a company of "elect" for His purpose. These are the special forces of Christ. They have been trained and tested to the nth degree. The Lamb has come to put an end to the kingdoms of men as we have known them. Note that in the verse quoted earlier, those running from the face of the One on the throne are the kings or rulers of the earth and all the "great men" or those in power. Indeed, the Lamb is the mighty power that is now shaking the kingdoms of men.

"The Lord hath made all things for himself: yea, even the wicked for the day of evil." (Prov.16:4) God is even using all the evil that we see to fulfill His own plan.

THE VIRGIN CHURCH

"And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his father's name written in their foreheads." (Rev.14:1) The number of these does not denote their quantity; it denotes their identity. 12 is the square root of 144 and 12 is the number of divine government. 3 is the number of divine perfection and 4 is the number of the earthly, organic creation.

,So 12 is the number of God's perfect rule in His creation. God ordained 12 patriarchs to govern His first chosen nation. He chose 12 disciples as the foundation for His church or His Israel from above.

These 144,000 have their roots in 12 which is God's divine rule for His creation. They are His church, His Body, His Israel from above, the sons of God. And they have His (the Lamb's) Father's nature written in their minds (foreheads). They have the mind and nature of Christ and their thoughts are in unison with His thoughts, their ways with His ways. They follow the Lamb wherever He goes. Actually, the Lamb is now their lives; they are His image or representatives in the earth. The Lamb has led them to the cross daily, and He is leading them to full victory over evil.

One of the most significant attributes of this company of firstfruits is that they are virgins. "These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being THE FIRSTFRUITS UNTO GOD AND TO THE LAMB." (Rev.14:4) They were redeemed from among men, so they were not always virgins.

When we were part of the "woman" that sits on many waters, whether it was the Roman Catholic Church, any of her protesting daughters, any of the many independent groups or any of the gods of this world, we were not virgins. In God's economy, we were still yielding ourselves to other lovers and had not yet fully turned back to our first love.

When we were redeemed, the Spirit began to "Sanctify (set us apart for His purpose) and cleanse us with the washing of water by the word, that he might present us to himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle, or any such thing, but that we should be holy and without blemish." (Eph.5: 26-27) And when He separated us unto Himself, He was making us virgins.

His church will be spotless and free from the sins of the flesh (wrinkles, spots and blemishes). This is being done little by little by the Spirit. We might have thought that we could do it by our own "will power" but when we tried to make rules for ourselves, we quickly discovered the futility of it all. There is nothing we can do to make ourselves pure, holy and virgins. This can only be done by the Spirit of God. Some have moved to wilderness places trying to separate themselves from the world. They have raised their children in pristine environments yet when the children became of age, the world beckoned unto them from within their hearts, and they could not wait to go taste of its forbidden fruit. Separation unto Him is a change of heart and God is the only One who can accomplish that. Trying to change ourselves by changing our behavior will fail. But when God changes our hearts, it changes our behavior.

Recently God tested me. I had been enjoying a book written by a dedicated French philosopher. He has since passed away, but by his writings one knows that he was a man who sought to know God in a deeper way. He has done intensive research in the field of the spirit. I found this book very interesting and enjoyed it, even though as I got into more into it, I was impressed to be cautious and to not let my thoughts be carried away.

Soon I found out that the Lord was not pleased with my new found interest. He gave me this dream, "I lived in a very large house with a long hallway separating my bedroom from the rest of the house. This man was staying in my house. He was very playful and for a time I enjoyed going along with him in his frolicking. I knew in my heart that I would never yield myself to him and so I felt that it was not right for me to entertain him as I did. I turned away from him and left him. I walked down my long hallway back to my bedroom."

It did not take long when I woke up to know what the dream was about. The Lord was warning me. The interesting book that I was reading had the potential to take over my thoughts. It was occupying too much of my attention. That man's thoughts were similar to what the Spirit was speaking to me, but they did not come from the right source.

Although they sounded very spiritual, they were not from the Holy Spirit; they were from another spirit. They could defile my spirit the same way that a man defiles a woman. My turning away in the dream and walking through the long hallway back to my bedroom shows that I returned to my place of rest and left this "man". I quickly got rid of that book and

will never pick it up again. Later, I looked up this writer's name on the Internet and found his picture there. Indeed, it was the man in my dream.

Does this mean that we must censor all books and read only our Bibles? Oh No! There were many trees in the garden and only one tree was forbidden. This means that it is lawful for us to feed our souls with many interesting subjects. God has made them for our learning and entertainment. We can play games that we enjoy and study things that we need to know; we are free in Christ to enjoy many things. However, in our spiritual growth AS SONS, there are things that can hinder and slow us down. They can cause us to take a detour.

Paul was pressing for the high calling of God in Christ He explains, "All things are lawful unto me, but all things are not expedient. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought down under the power of any." (I Cor.6:12) And again, "All things are lawful for me, but all things are not expedient; all things are lawful for me, but all things edify not." (I Cor. 10: 23)

The word "expedient" means "Fit or suitable for the purpose- Proper under the circumstance." This means that even though some things are not sins to us, they are not suitable or fit to serve God's purpose in our lives. They are not proper for us to use due to our calling in Christ. They are fine for others but they are a waste of time, and they just do not edify us.

"And they sang as it were a new song before the throne..." (Vs.3a) A song that no one else could learn but these sons. John saw them later, standing on the sea of glass, having the harps of God. They had gotten the victory over the beast (nature of man), and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, "And they sang the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb..." (Rev.15: 3a)

As sons they will sing the song of Moses in the face of the Pharaohs (ruling spirits) that are keeping multitudes in the cruel bondage of the darkness and death under the greedy systems of this world. They will lift up their voices loud and clear, sustained by God's

power. And in perfect unison their song will ring out, "LET MY PEOPLE GO!"

And they will sing the Song of the Lamb which declares that "THE BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST HIS SON CLEANSES US FROM ALL SINS." (I Jn.1:7)
