### *Game Changers Revealed in Translations of The Hebrew Gospels and Brit Hadashah!*

It is a four-page fragment, a single large page which when folded makes four pages. It is part of a quire, a stack of such pages which when inserted one into the next and bound together make a codex, a book - this book was *The Hebrew Gospels* - it has the first page of Luke and of John! It uses the name Yehovah consistently. I have personally examined this fragment at the Vatican Library.

Although many Messianic scribes followed the Jewish conventions of writing substitute names for Yehovah such as Hashem, Adonai, etc., now we know that many Messianic scribes did not and remained true to the sacred name Yehovah (& Yeshua) despite both Jewish and Gentile prohibition of the sacred name.

We are talking about Yehovah’s instructions for our lives and our salvation! In our translation of the Hebrew Epistle of James we find, not the word “law” but the word “*Torah*” in several places! If that does not seem like a game changer to you consider this: If “law” is “*Torah*” then “lawless” is “*without Torah*.” How does that change the Gentile Christian understanding of Matthew 7:22-23?

“Many will say to me in that day, ‘*Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in your name? And in your name have cast out demons? And in your name done many wonderful works?*’”

“And then will I profess unto them, ‘*I never knew you: Get away from me you who are without Torah!*’”
