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COMING IN FOR A LANDING

The apostle John was on the Isle of Patmos, in the Spirit and on the Lord's day, when he recorded all that he saw and heard. Physically he was on a Greek island, but his spirit was transported into another place, into a time that was yet to be lived in the earth. For this reason, all that he saw and heard on that day, must be interpreted by the revelation of the Spirit. The book that compiles his visions is called "The Revelation of Jesus Christ," because in it, our Lord reveals Himself in the power of His resurrection life. He is no longer the good Shepherd of the Gospels; He is now the Conqueror of all evil, in heaven and in earth. This is the book of victory over all the hostilities and maliciousness that stand against the true God. When understood by the Spirit of truth, it is the most detailed, valiant and glorious saga of the victory of good over evil, yet it can also be most horrible and terrifying when interpreted by the literal understanding of man. The truth is that it can best be understood as it is lived. *"Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and **keep those things which are written therein**, for the time is at hand."* (Rev.1:3) To be blessed with understanding the depth of this prophecy, is to "keep those things which are written therein." This means, to actually live them or fulfill them. Because it was not yet time, men have struggled to understand and have come up with many vague and even erroneous interpretations. However, we are now living in the times of the end, and the things written therein, are becoming clearer when compared with current events.

Throughout the past ages, God has had a people who fulfilled His will for their day. As waves that roll upon the seashores, God brings new revelations about His plan for creation. With every wave, those who are called out have taken their place and raised their banners to proclaim the truth they received. The book of Hebrews names those of the far past, who fulfilled their calling for their day, and closer to us, we think of such as Joan of Arc, Mme Guillon, Brother Lawrence, Jane Leade, Thomas Merton, and many who dedicated and gave their lives to preserve the Word of truth among faithless and perverse generations. Closer to us, we can name such as the many brethren who began the "latter rain" and Pentecostal movements of the early twentieth century. It is during the time of these "moves," that the Spirit of God within man continued the task of preparing a people for the work of the end of the age.

These people are followers of the Lamb of God, therefore they are a sacrificial people, chosen in Christ as a firstfruit offering unto God. They do not fit into the church systems of the world, and find themselves rejected because of their word and their convictions. *"If you were of the world, the world would love his own; but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you."* (Jn.15:19) Jesus told Peter, *"Upon this rock I will build my church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against her."* (Matt.16:18) Man has erected many beautiful buildings called "Church," but the true church exists in the spirits and hearts of those who are called for this time.

Followers of the Lamb are also called the church that Jesus has been building in secret, *"This is a great mystery; but I speak concerning Christ and the church."* (Eph.5:32) The church is the bride of the Lamb. He has been preparing her for Himself, working from within, where no man could enter. He has been changing her affections and wooing her unto Himself. Through His blood sacrifice, Jesus has crucified our old Adam man and has freed the woman, the soul from the law of that man. We were married to the first Adam man and we had to serve the law of that man as long as he lived. *"For the*

woman which hath an husband is bound by the law to her husband so long as he liveth; but if the husband be dead, she is loosed from the law of her husband.” (Rom.7:2) As long as we were married to the old man Adam, we were not free to wed our new husband Christ. By His death, the Lord has set us free from our first husband Adam and the law of sin and death. By His Spirit, He has set us apart and has been cleansing our souls of all impurities of the flesh (spots and wrinkles), turning our hearts to loving Him who is the truth, and getting us ready for our union with Himself.

This is the love story which has been unfolding within us. It is the unveiling of our union with the One who is Spirit and Truth. There can be no manifestation of sons, without the union of spirit and soul. There needs to be a bride yielding to her bridegroom to produce a son in us. Comparing a man and his wife to the Spirit and the bride, Paul urges us to yield unto Christ, *“That he might sanctify her, (set her apart for Himself), and cleanse her with the washing of the water by the word, That he might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.”* (Eph.5:26-27). These words are often read to teach husbands to be kind to their wives, but the heart of these words reveals the great love and work that Christ is doing to prepare His church. He is loving her so that she might love Him enough to marry Him! The beauty of a bride on her wedding day is not only found in her beautiful gown; it is found in the love that lights up her eyes and her entire countenance. Jesus is not only separating His bride from the world; He is separating her from the love of the world. And all this is being done in secret. It is taking place in her soul and spirit while her outer form remains the same. However, the day of her revealing is at hand.

On February 5, 2022, I received this dream, *“I am living in a very large city; not a bustling city with tall buildings and such, but mainly a vast area of much land, of freedom and fresh air, much like a park. Suddenly, I have the feeling that we are slowly descending, somewhat like in an airliner. Indeed, the entire city is coming down like if it were a plane landing. At first the feeling was almost imperceptible, but now we are coming down faster and coming closer to the earth. I look around for a pilot, and see a glassed-in area with this man sitting very straight, looking ahead and very focused on the landing. On the earth I can see things that are in the way of the landing, and hope that we will miss hitting them. But here we come and the pilot very steadily misses all the obstructions, although at times it’s a very close call. I watch him sitting straight in his seat and not making a move yet looking everywhere. I keep looking at the pilot still immobile and looking straight forward bringing this whole city down for a smooth landing.”*

When John saw the new heaven and the new earth, he also beheld that city. *“And I John saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.”* (Rev.21:2) What John saw was the church of the Firstborn, the entire congregation of saints from both sides of the veil, who had been hidden and prepared. He saw us, as we are now beginning to make our descent to the earth. All that we are in Spirit, will be made manifest in earth. This city, is under the guidance and power of the steady hands and keen mind of a Pilot who has been with her all along. And John heard a great voice saying, *“Behold the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain; for the former things are passed away.”* (Rev.21:3-4) The former things that produced death and pain are the bodies of this death, but soon God Himself will manifest the life of His Son in newness of life, in body, soul and spirit.
