Part 7:

“They are Confused about Holidays/Holy Days”

How so?

The church-system substituted their Holidays for the Biblical Holy Days. These holidays are now well-established religious tradition. The church bragged about their power above the Word of God to be able to change the days & seasons. It was done by replacing the Biblical calendar with their own, switching Sabbath to Sun-Day as the day of rest, and in “Christianizing” pagan holidays in place of the Biblical Holy Days.

There are eight of these Holy Days (set-apart convocation days), clustered into three, (Leviticus 23). They are called in Western culture, “Passover,” “Pentecost,” and “Tabernacles.” The Hebrew-culture names are “Pesach,” “Shavuot,” and “Succot.” The Feasts of Unleavened Bread are part of the Passover celebration. The Feasts of Trumpets & the Day of Atonement are part of the Tabernacles days.

Keeping these special days of Passover/Pesach reminds us of the Exodus from cruel Egypt, a shadow of the greater Exodus from the corrupt global world system of Satan. This Greater Exodus is in progress now. Passover/Pesach also reminds us of when salvation came through the blood-sacrifice of our perfect Lamb of God, Y’shua, who atoned for the transgressions of Adam, (including all those from Adam).

Pentecost/Shavuot, like Passover, is also a spring feast. Pentecost/Shavuot reminds us of the infilling of God’s Spirit. The purpose of this “Baptism in His Spirit” is to change us into His character & nature. This infilling is made possible by the Passover/Pesach atonement. Both spring feasts have prophetic meaning. Together they are the former rain of His Spirit to soften the hearts of mankind, receive His seed, & grow with His heart & mind.

Keeping Tabernacles/Succot reminds us of the wilderness journey of the Israelites (while dwelling in tents), before they entered the Promised Land. One prophetic symbolism here is that our mortal bodies are the “tents” that we dwell in while growing into full maturity in Messiah, (Ephesians 4:13). Like the Messiah, we are made into His

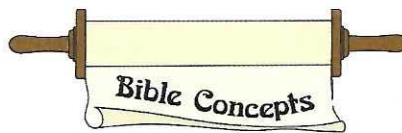
character & nature by the things that we suffer in our wilderness journey, (Hebrews 5:8). Entering the Promised Land (the Messiah), is the promise of being able to come into the full stature of Messiah, which concludes with receiving our inheritance, (our immortal bodies at the resurrection). This feast (along with others associated with it), are all in the 7th-Biblical month. It is the time of the final ingathering from the gardens, orchards, vineyards, & fields.

It also speaks of the final ingathering at the end of the age, when all (godly & evil), are made evident because it is the time of coming to full fruit. The tares are removed & destroyed, while the wheat is gathered (converged/networked), together, (in unison).

The 6,000 years of rule by fallen man (in the lap of Satan), is over. The 1,000 years of the righteous ruling in Messiah ruling is here. The difficult initial 7-year transition time is over at the end of 2024. Satan knows his time is short, but does not want to give up his rule over the earth. So, he comes as a dragon spewing a flood of lies, but that fails, so he overplays his hand by coming forth with great fury through his agents to rob, kill & destroy. That too will fall short of its final goal.

These are the most exciting times to be alive! We express this & see so much more when we keep the Holy Days, a great joy for those of us who have entered into those Holy (set-apart), Convocations, (assemblies).

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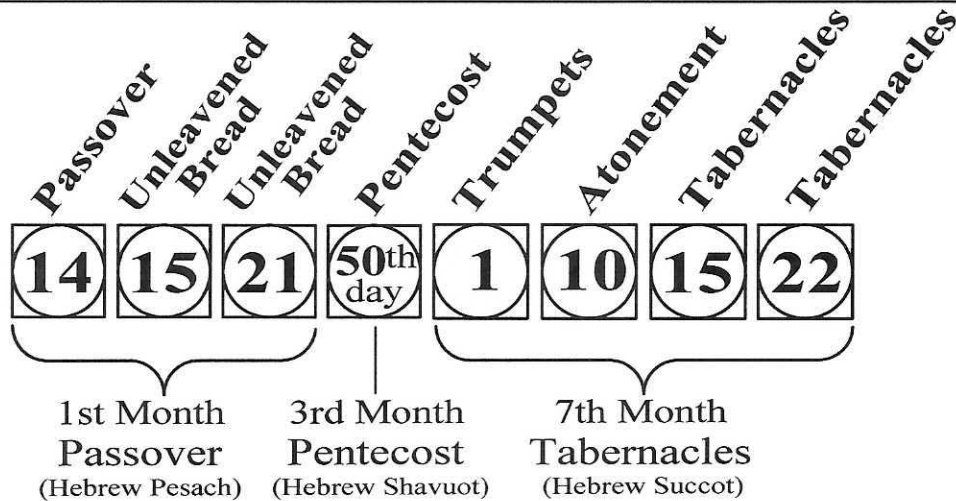


Revealing the Big Picture

Here are the main "Feasts" that Y'hovah's people are to always keep:



And here are some hidden patterns of prophetic words:

<p>Passover (Pesach) (Gospels)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -the firstfruit -barley (1 sheaf) -Wave Offering (small harvest) -resurrection (Y'shua/Jesus) -<u>Word</u> made flesh in one man -1st witness 	<p>Pentecost (Shavuot) (Acts)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -the firstfruits -wheat (2 loaves) -larger harvest -the ekklesia -Holy <u>Spirit</u> in many -2nd witness 	<p>Tabernacles (Succot) (Revelation)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -the firstfruits company -wine & oil -largest & final harvest the "Sons/ Overcomers" -His <u>Life</u> in a people -3rd witness
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These 2-witnesses of Word & Spirit (spring feasts/former rain), soon "die," in the streets, but are raised up in the fullness of the Life of the Messiah as the 3rd-witness of Sons (fall feasts/latter rain), at the final harvest in the last days.
