Yahshua's Ministry Not 3 & 1/2 Years

It has been a long-entrenched teaching of the religious church system that the ministry of our Messiah, Yahshua (Jesus), was 3 & 1/2 years, but is that scriptural?

Yahshua announced the beginning of his ministry in Luke 4:18-19, in the synagogue of Natzaret (Nazareth), quoting Isaiah 61:1-2(a). This was right after returning from the victory of his temptations, which followed immediately after his Baptism in God's Spirit.

And what did he proclaim? He declared that the power of the Spirit of Yahovah (God), was now upon him to begin his ministry...the beginning of *THE ACCEPTABLE YEAR of Yahovah*. The end of the acceptable year as the Passover Lamb was his death & resurrection, also confirmed by the anointing of his disciples in God's Spirit 7-weeks after his death, on the day of Shavuot, (Pentecost).

His death was on Passover, at the time when the Passover Lambs were slain. Indeed, 1Corinthians 5:7 tells us that Yahshua is our Passover Lamb to atone for our sins. To qualify, he had to be a male without blemish *ABOUT A YEAR OLD*, (Exodus 12). He was without blemish after walking about a year in the overcoming might of Yahovah's Spirit. He also had to be inspected on the 10th through the 14th day of the first Biblical month, which he was by the religious leaders, who could find no fault, then gave the "go-ahead" to have him sacrificed as a substitute for all the people, (not realizing what they were doing, John 11:49-52). Pilate also found him to be without fault. Furthermore, his blood had to be on a wooden post at a gateway. He shed his blood on a wooden post at a key juncture of the populace, with a sign in 3-languages reading that he was the (Messianic) King.

In addition, as the Passover Lamb, he fulfilled having no bones broken. And his flesh was to be eaten, which was done as a type by eating bread representing him, the Bread of Life. His life seen in our lives is the result.

THIS ACCEPTABLE YEAR was prophesied in Daniel 9:21-27 as 70-weeks, with him cut off after 62-weeks. We have a detailed colorful, easy-to-read 8-foot chart from (aroodawakening.tv), that lays out precisely the 70-weeks (490 days), from the day of his baptism in the Spirit until the day that his disciples were baptized in the Spirit. This chart overlaps with a sequential chronology of all 4-Gospels & the Feasts of God.

More than a dozen early church fathers also state that his ministry was about year. So how did the unscriptural "3 & 1/2 year ministry fabrication" originate? It traces to

Eusebius, the good friend of the pagan Roman Emperor, Constantine, (early 4th-century). It was when Constantine & the Pope rewrote the Bible for their purposes that Eusebius (known as unethical & a forger), inserted John 6:4 to add another "Passover," but those knowing God's Feast Days & Calendar spotted this as out of place at that time of year.

The religious world missed the Messiah's 1st-coming as the Head, (the sacrificial Lamb). Now they are missing how & when he is coming "the 2nd-time" through his people as the conquering Lion-King in his Body. I have "the 2nd-coming" in quotes because he has been coming continually in and through his people both individually & together; however, this "2nd coming" will stand out as an undeniable world-recognized event of the 1st-resurrection of his overcomers to take charge on earth.
