



Millennial-Kingdom Myths Part 1

“Millennial” denotes 1,000 years, descriptive of the 1,000 year reign of peace on earth, (mentioned 6-times in Revelation Chapter 20). This is the time when all the Kingdoms of this world become the Kingdom of our Messiah, (Revelation 11:15), (and thus the significance of His many crowns).

Religious traditions embedded many fanciful unscriptural ideas into our heads of what that time looks like. Among the many myths, let’s start with the Messiah returning on a flying horse, descending from the clouds. What does the Bible say? We look to all of Revelation Chapter 19 for context, then zero in on verses 11-17).

Doesn’t verse 11 say that Messiah comes from the heavens on a white horse? Yes, but this whole passage is not literal, but rather figurative imagery with each part signifying something else. We know this because the sword coming out of His mouth is explained a few verses later to represent the Word of God.

The overall chapter describes the judgment & destruction of the wicked. By His Spirit within us we see that what destroys the enemies of God is not a sword, but the flood of truth that comes forth from the Messiah, (backed up by those that follow the King of all Kingdoms). This truth is not just religious Bible jargon, for the Word is far more than that. The Word sets the standard as the touchstone of Truth, double-edged for what is acceptable and what is not, right versus wrong, good versus evil, life versus death, in *ALL* areas of life.

This aggression of truth is what we are seeing now, no longer trampled & suppressed! Truth is rising up about our food, our medicine, social security & Medicare theft, greedy politicians siphoning off billions of our tax dollars, judicial bribery, the double lives of so many religious leaders, the perversion & rebellion in the education system, and much more! The truth brings accountability, tares being pulled.

The avalanche of truth exposes all hidden things, so that the tares can be clearly identified & distinguished from the wheat. Then the tares are removed without any

mercy! For the Messiah & those who are one with Him, begin to rule with a rod of iron, smashing the enemy into oblivion. Time is up for the corrupt.

Messiah the Head, and Messiah the Body all ride on white horses. The horses are beasts and therefore represent the earthly natural realm. Yet the horses are white, signifying clean, pure, and of righteousness. Their beast nature has changed from selfishness to one of submissive obedience to their masters. They have the mind of the Messiah. They go wherever He directs them. They have been trained, tested, and proven faithful. Together, both horse & rider are one, the heavenly soul seen in the physical realm. First they are seen in their physical bodies by those with “eyes to see,” but then they are seen by all when they receive their resurrected bodies.

Those who rule with a rod of iron are specified (in Revelation 2:26-27 and 12:5), as “the overcomers,” and the “Firstborn Sons of God.” Indeed, these are those blessed to be in the earlier resurrection, (Luke 20:35-36), during the first part of the Millennial Kingdom. This resurrection soon follows the current acceleration of the full exposure & removal of the tares. We note that Messiah positions his army strategically to key places of dominion, authority, & power over the nations, (Revelation 2:26)...happening now.
